At 14 years old, Elizabeth* was faced with an impossible choice. Drop out of school because her grandmother could no longer afford to pay the fees to send her, or be used by men for sex in order to earn money for school. Her friends had already made the desperate choice to earn money in this way.

Elizabeth and her grandmother fled their home country of South Sudan because of the war when Elizabeth was only six years old, leaving her parents and siblings behind. They ended up living as refugees in Uganda, where girls in her community are at high risk of abuse and exploitation. They live in scarcity and fear, with very little hope.

Elizabeth dropped out of school and began being used by men for money. She hoped to one day return to school. "I cried so much during that time in my life," she said. "I would cry myself to sleep. I hated what was happening to me."

Elizabeth's friends who were also being exploited in this way tried to tell her everything would be ok, but Elizabeth was deeply suffering, living in darkness for years.

Then a new friend invited Elizabeth to church. For the first time, she heard there is a God who loves her, who cares about her pain, and who wants good things for her. Through the church she joined a She Is Safe Group where she experienced a loving, safe environment and a place to share her heart. She also learned about earning and saving money and became equipped with vocational and leadership skills. Now she is 18 years old with dreams for a new life.

"I no longer cry myself to sleep," she said. "My dream is to go back to school and become a doctor."

God sees the suffering and exploitation of girls like Elizabeth all over the world, and He also sees your heartbreak on their behalf. Your support is what brings His light to them in the midst of their darkness and transforms their stories. Thank you for impacting the thousands of vulnerable lives you have changed this year. INDONESIA

"My stepfather abused me, and I was powerless to stop him. I also suffered at school, where I was cruelly bullied. I ran away to a tourist city, where I began letting men use my body for money. I contracted a disease, and wanted to end my own life. I came to a Safe House, where I received mental health care and education. I was able to get treatment for my disease, which healed. My mentors at the Safe House have taught me about love and forgiveness. They have shared about how God has changed their lives, and now He is changing mine, too."

- 22 women and girls were rescued from abuse, trafficking or prostitution.
- 47 women and girls received care and training so they can focus on building better lives for themselves.
- **760 women in 70** She Is Safe Groups received access to group savings and developed emotional and financial resilience.
- 13,280 at-risk children and teenagers were equipped with education, made safer from predators, and gained good nutrition.

NEPAL

"I always wanted to learn how to read and write, but I never had the chance. I want my daughter to have a better life for herself than mine. I have also been living in fear that she will be sold and I'll never see her again, because this happens to many girls in our community. Now there is a new teacher in our village, and it is clear she loves the children and cares for them. She also teaches the parents about health, safety and hygiene. We have learned about healthy meals to feed our children before they come to school. I am so grateful for her, and I am hopeful for my daughter's future."

MIDDLE EAST

"I was depressed and hopeless because my husband was unable to work due to his health, and we had no money. We struggled to afford food or the medicine my husband needed. I didn't know how we were going to survive. Then my friend invited me to join a She Is Safe Group. In this group I learned about health, savings and lending, and the wisdom of God. Now I feel God's hand on me, and He gives me peace, serenity and confidence. I prayed for my husband, and now he is healed. He was able to go back to work, but in addition to his income, I had already begun saving and generating an income due to what I learned in my She Is Safe Group."

- 93 refugee women and girls received vocational training such as tailoring to keep them safe from being trafficked in forced and child marriages.
- 234 women in 16 She Is Safe Groups received leadership skill development and access to group loans.

MIDDLE EAST

366 refugee girls developed leadership skills and were trained in trafficking and abuse prevention to protect them from being taken in child marriage.

INDIA

3,579 women in 234 She Is Safe Groups received income generating skills that help them be self-sustaining and less vulnerable to exploiters.

NEPAL

106 women and girls became less vulnerable to trafficking through the income generating animal husbandry program.

MYANMAR

704 women and teenagers in 50 She Is Safe Groups received life skills training, peer support, anti-trafficking and abuse awareness training.

UGANDA

75 women and teens gained leadership skills, lending and livelihood in 4 She Is Safe Groups.

SOUTH SUDAN

778 women and teens gained skills to start businesses to help protect their families in She Is Safe Groups.

INDONESIA

65,393 children and community members received training in abuse and trafficking prevention.

ACROSS THE COUNTRIES WHERE WE WORK:

- 6,130 women in She Is Safe Groups received skills to become self-sustaining and less vulnerable to exploitation.
- 14,531 children, teenagers and young women were set on a path to a future of freedom.
- 1,567 women were equipped to become leaders in their small groups and communities.
- 254 teenage girls delayed marriage by at least one year.





INDIA

"I have a skin condition that people in my community are afraid is contagious, so their children aren't allowed to play with me. I have been isolated and so lonely for years, but I recently joined a Junior She Is Safe Group. In this group I have friends, and I know the leaders love me. They tell me how much God loves me, too, just as I am. I have also learned to sew, and now I can make cloth bags. My leaders teach me how to protect myself from abuse, and they help me with my education. I am not alone anymore."

Look what you made possible in India . . .

- 17 girls were rescued from being trafficked.
- 811 children children at risk of trafficking and abuse were provided educational support, instruction in personal care and improved nutrition.
- **215 leaders** were equipped to help women start micro-enterprise She Is Safe Groups.
- **1,155 women** were equipped to become leaders in their small groups and communities.
- **26 girls** received shelter, counseling and vocational training or education so they can build self-sustaining lives of freedom.

MYANMAR

"I spent all my time gambling, neglecting my four children. They had to beg for food. Eventually my husband abandoned us after fighting with me all the time. I felt hopeless, but then women from a She Is Safe Group came to my home and showed me love. They invited me to join their group, and I did. All the women welcomed me. When I got a job washing clothes, they taught me how to save money. I have learned how to love my children and take care of them, and I recently took out a loan from the group to start my own business. Now my family can eat every day."
